School:

2. **Provide logistics:** room (MUR), room layout, tables, PA system, chair set-up, custodian assistance and confirm with MFMII Event Coordinator.
3. **Promote the event** in school newsletter, flyer distribution, announcements, post flyer/poster on school bulletin boards.
4. **Collect RSVPs** and create list for event sign-in sheet to include parent/ guardian name, student name and grade level and email to mfm2events@gmail.com .

1. Coordinate the three stations providing songs / activities / instruments.
2. We will have a sign-up sheet for docent recruitment and will follow-up with those interested.
