Planning Responsibilities:

School:

1. **Select date and time** in April or May (1 hour minimum eg 7-8pm or 6:30-7:30pm) and coordinate with the MFMII Event Coordinator, email: events@musicforminors2.org .
2. **Promote the event** in school newsletter, flyer distribution, announcements.

MFMII:

1. **Coordinate** the FMN providing songs / activities.
2. **Collect RSVPs**. Parents can sign up for a FMN using a Google form.
3. We will follow up with attendees for those interested in docent training.
