MFMII is happy to partner with the Fremont Symphony Orchestra (FSO) as we mutually promote the arts in the community. Partnering will consist of promotion of our mutual events and ongoing communication of our needs. We will be sharing a booth at the Fremont Arts and Wine Festival and can distribute our recruitment flyers at FSO events. In addition, the <u>FSO</u> and Fremont Youth Symphony Orchestra (<u>FYSO</u>) will offer their talents in our booths or at docent sharing workshops. We plan to have a workshop on the instruments of the orchestra that might include some members of the FSO as presenters.

Remember to visit the MFMII / FSO booth in the kids zone at the Fremont Festival of the Arts on August 5th and 6th. Everyone is welcome! Make an egg shaker maraca, learn a dance, play the tonebells or boomwhackers and listen to music from Fremont Youth Symphony Orchestra and the Virtuoso International Flute Ensemble (VIFE).

New! MFMII Instrument Starter Kits (MISKs)

Following the success of the Charlotte Diamond Concert, MFMII offered MISKs to schools without a MFMII resource center. The MISKS include an assortment of instruments for classroom use by children and docents. The kits have been a hit and will make life easier for our docents.

Another beautiful story of our program's impact this year, came from a new Castro Valley Docent at Chabot School, Teresa Talbot. She shared that once she started to invite parents with varied cultural backgrounds to share music from their homeland, students began to become more engaged. In fact, she made sure that each child's homeland songs were modeled so that the children could learn them all. Each child received a booklet with songs in Spanish, French, Chinese, etc. In one child's case, he made a complete transformation from a shy, uninterested student to a fully engaged and joyful one who was so proud to see his mother share music from his homeland with others. He remained engaged for the rest of the school year as that experience opened him up to the wide world of music. Hats off to Docent Teresa for her successful engagement of parents in our MFMII class lessons and for meeting her students' needs. The whole class experienced the beauty of being united in song.

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
