Lydia's husband, Red Concepcion, a professional musician himself, serves as the accompanist. In March, the choir gave its first live performances since the pandemic, at the Fremont Council PTA Founders' Day Celebration & at Niles School for their Sing For Spring Concert - great songs, positive messages, beautiful singing and choreography.
